

Tips for parents and caregivers on *after school activities*

It is important to ask the following questions before you entrust your child to child care programs. Knowledge is power -- by making an informed decision, you can ensure that your child has a wonderful, exciting, and above all, safe experience.

- Does the program conduct background checks on all employees?
- How is staff screened?
- Does the agency/program have a policy in place that no child is to be left alone with an adult?
- What is the ratio of staff to children?
- What trainings do staff receive to keep children safe?
- Does this place have a child protection policy regarding how they report suspected abuse?
- Does the policy mandate reporting to all authorities?
- How does the agency handle emergencies?
